*Willow Hall was established in June of 1994 in response to this right.*

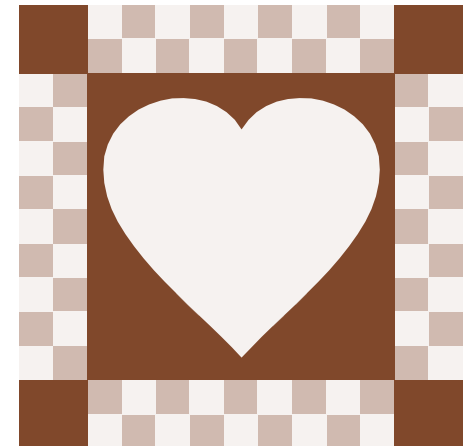

## THE ENVIRONMENT

Willow Hall's physical environment has been specially adapted to improve each resident's potential to become more independent. A large central hallway flanked on either side by private or semi-private bedrooms, a spacious living room and large dining room are adjoined by a restroom for easy access.

Weather permitting, residents may access a lovely outdoor courtyard enclosed by a decorative security fence. A specially designed "walking loop" within the courtyard often helps ambulatory residents who feel restless to relax by providing a physical outlet for their excess energy.

Willow Hall is a "secured" unit with a special magnetic locking system which provides a fire-safe exit yet limits unauthorized entry and exit. Together, the physical characteristics of Willow Hall provide *safety, security and support* for residents.



## FAMILY INVOLVEMENT



Family members and friends are always welcome to visit. Children and pets, too!

Once relieved of the stress of 24-hour care giving, family members often find the quality of their time with their loved one is much improved. Although our staff will try hard to be a second family, we realize that no one can take your place.
